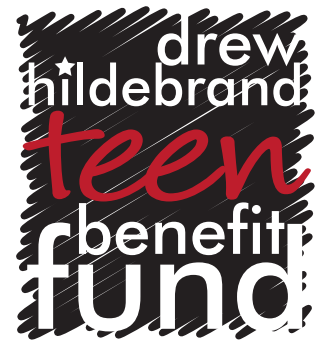


It takes courage to change.



The Drew Hildebrand Teen Benefit Fund has been established in memory of Drew, who died on April 8, 2008 as a victim of teen violence at the age of 16. Drew was loving, caring, compassionate and funny,

and had the rare ability to raise smiles and brighten hearts wherever he went. He touched many people's lives and continues to be a positive influence with all.

Drew's scholarship

The Drew Hildebrand Teen Benefit Fund will recognize and reward positive change through individual scholarships for post secondary education and/or training programs. Scholarships will be awarded to graduating teens who have demonstrated turnaround initiative. While a scholarship will be awarded at Drew's high school, Thomas A. Blakelock High School in Oakville, the Fund has expanded to more Halton, Peel and Greater Toronto Area high schools so that as many turnaround teens as possible can pursue a better life.

Funding support for programs dedicated to teens

The Drew Hildebrand Teen Benefit Fund also aims to provide funding support for select programs that help teens achieve their goals of change and success.



The mission of the Drew Hildebrand Teen Benefit Fund is to support teens who are navigating the many pressures and dangers of violence, drugs, alcohol, among others.
